

## Climbing/Rappelling Instructors Course



The course goal is to ensure that you can safely and effectively manage a climbing program for your unit. It will help you to solidify your knowledge of climbing and to bring it into line with the current policies of the BSA. This course is intended for any adult who meets the prerequisites and is interested in teaching the basics of climbing and rappelling. Upon successful completion of this course, you will receive a certificate as a “BSA Climbing Instructor”. You are then able to act as a “Qualified Instructor” at a unit, district or council Climbing/Rappelling activity.

**You must have a moderate level of prerequisite knowledge and experience in belaying, knots, equipment and hardware in order to receive your instructor’s card at the end of this course.** Those with no previous knowledge or experience are welcome to attend, but may require more experience to qualify to be an instructor at the end of the course.
